**SUBJECT: ADHERENCE TO COVID-19 PROTOCOLS DURING THE 51<sup>ST</sup> GRADUATION CEREMONY**

---

As has been announced by the Ministry of Health, the Covid-19 positivity rate has steadily been on the rise. We are therefore required to adhere to the guidelines given by the government in order to contain and control the evident spread of Covid 19.

In this regard we need to take note of the following as we prepare for the 51<sup>st</sup> Graduation Ceremony to be held on **Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> July, 2022:**

- 1) The 51<sup>st</sup> Graduation Ceremony will be held in-person at the University Graduation Square.
- 2) Each graduand will **STRICTLY** be expected to be accompanied by **only two (2) guests** as per the invitation card.
- 3) **ONLY** guests with invitation cards will be allowed in the University.
- 4) It will be **MANDATORY** for all graduands and guests to put on face masks at all times while in the University compound.
- 5) All graduands and invited guests will be expected to strictly adhere to the Ministry of Health Protocols as follows:
  - Washing of hands with soap and clean running water or by sanitizing at all entry points.
  - Observing social distance as appropriate.
  - Practicing respiratory hygiene; Covering mouth and nose with bent elbow or tissue when coughing or sneezing.
  - Avoiding sharing of personal items such as headphones, pens etc.
- 6) All graduands and guests will be required to have been vaccinated before attending the Graduation Ceremony.
- 7) Avoid bringing with you more guests except the two (2) allowed. **Any extra guests will be turned away.**
- 8) Those with flu-like symptoms are strongly advised not to attend the Graduation Ceremony.
- 9) Failure to observe the above guidelines will be considered a violation of the Public Health Act.
